SCALING ICONS

When you scale a set of icons, you should keep consistent the proportion of the stroke to the size of the object. This way they appear to be truly the same icons when they are small as when they were big.

How do you do this?

You'll need to select a setting called "Scale Strokes & Effects."

- 1. Go to Illustrator > Preferences > General.
- 2. Then check the box for "Scale Strokes & Effects."

If you have any rounded corners, you will also want to check "Scale Corners."
