

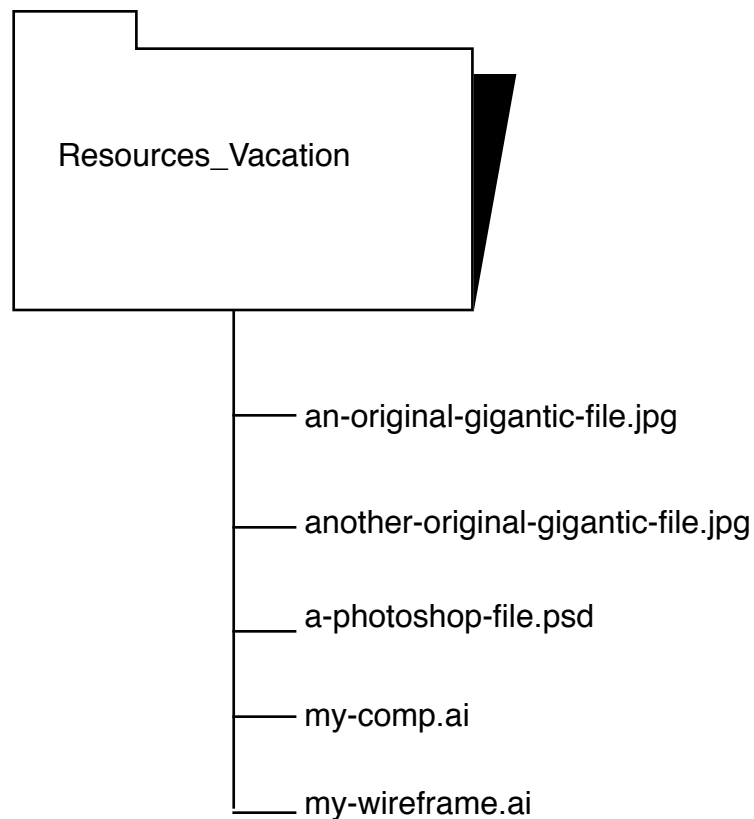
# Site Folder Setup for Vacation Site (Required)

Make 2 **SEPARATE** folders (You've probably already started the one on the left.)

1

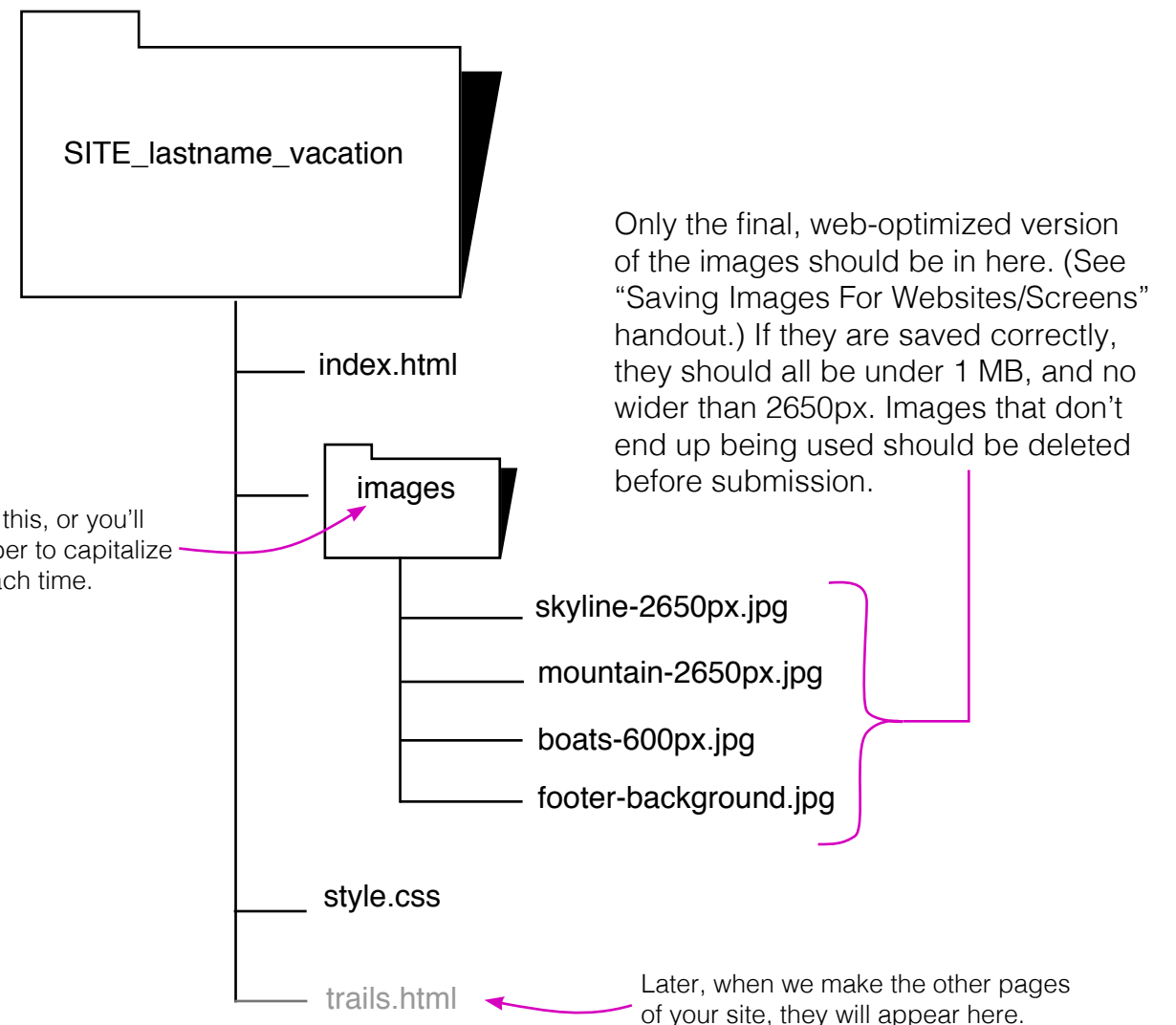
This folder has your original images as downloaded from Pixabay, as well as any PSD or AI files, such as your comp.

You will **not** be turning in this folder. (But you need it in order to make the things that go in the site folder.) These files will not be uploaded to the internet when/if you make your site live.



2

This folder has **ONLY** the files that will make your site work. This folder will be uploaded to the internet when/if you make your site live. It is this folder that you will turn in (uploading to Google Drive.)



# File Naming on the Web

**Reminder: Be careful how you name folders and files (including images!) for use on the web.**

- Avoid special characters in a file or folder name.
- Do not use any spaces in a file or folder name.
- Naming is case-sensitive.  
Note: You might get away with a case discrepancy on your local site, but when you upload the site to a server, links to your files may break.

**Once more for emphasis: PLEASE** only turn in images that have been properly saved for web/screens. Otherwise, it will quickly fill up my storage.
